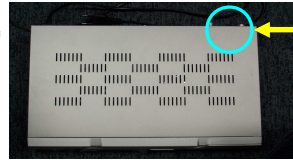


(b) RS232 Cable

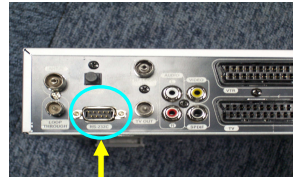

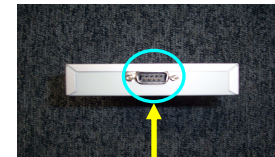
(b) RS232 cross cable



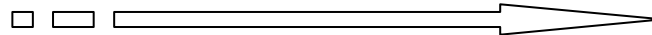
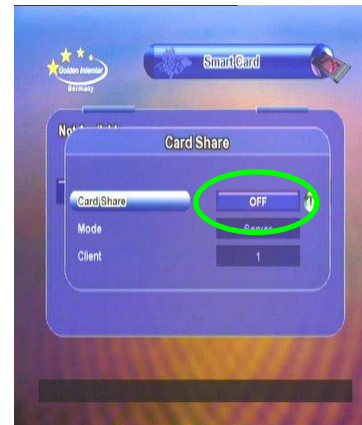
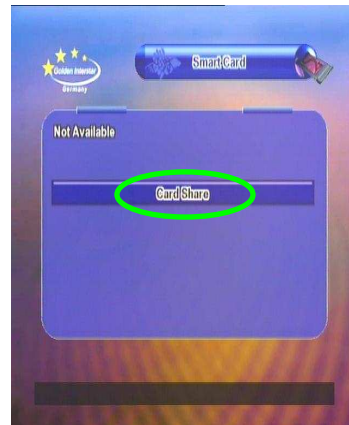
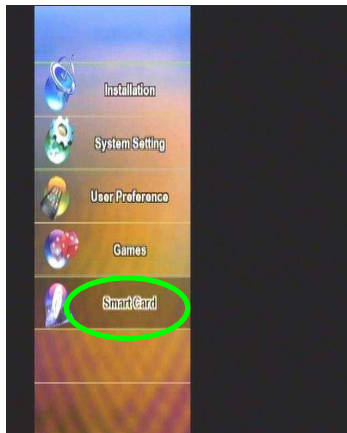

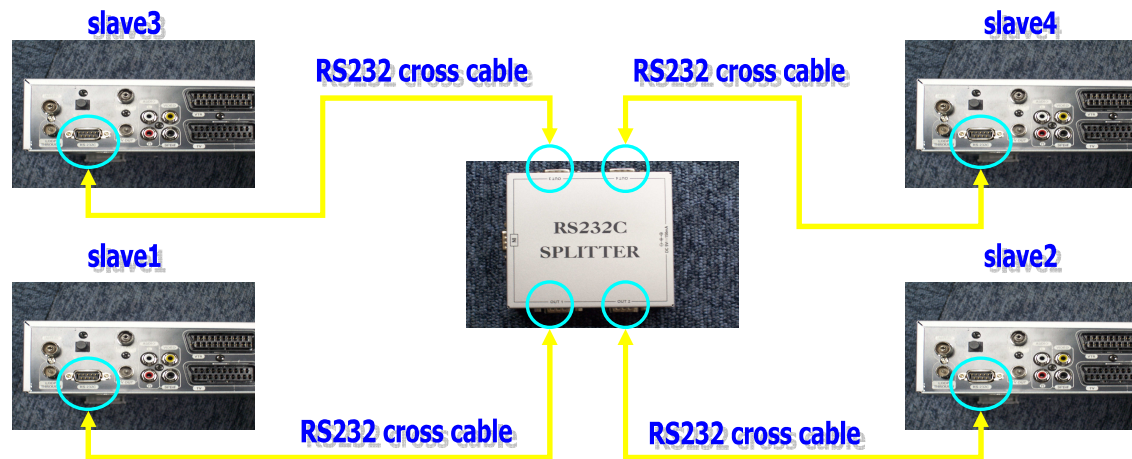

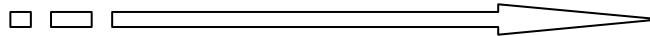

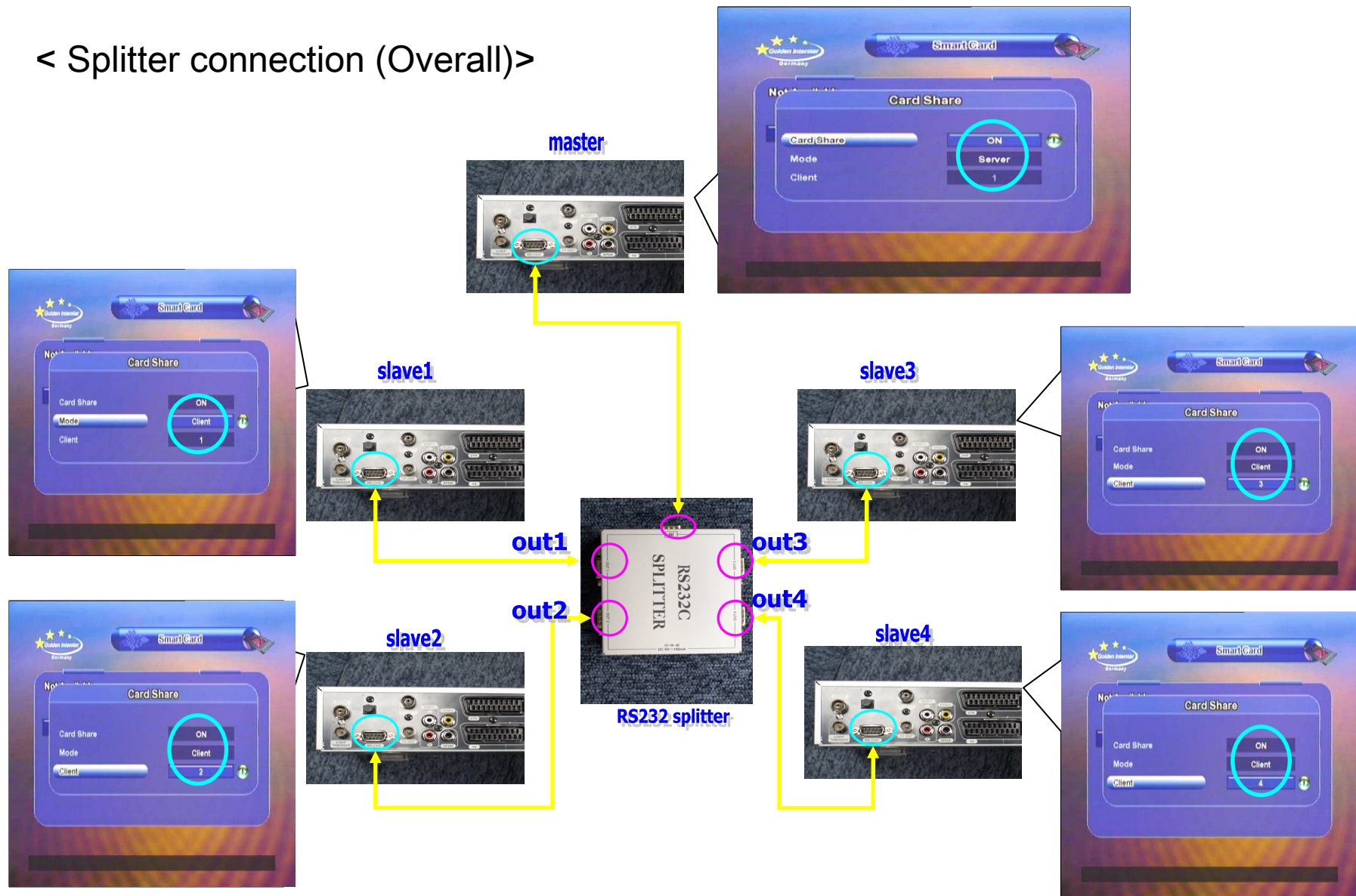

- **Connection Master – Splitter: (RS232 female-female)**

- 1 – free
- 2 – 3
- 3 – 2
- 4 – 4
- 5 – 5
- 6 – free
- 7 – free
- 8 – free
- 9 – free

- **Connection Slave – Splitter: (RS232 female-female)**

- 1 – free
- 2 – 3
- 3 – 2
- 4 – 6
- 5 – 5
- 6 – 4
- 7 – 8
- 8 – 7
- 9 – free

Direct connection (two receivers) without Splitter - use Slave-Splitter cable. Receivers should be „hot” connected and cannot be switched off (plug cable after switch ON receivers)
